TO: South Carolina Explosive Storage Magazine Permit Holders

SUBJECT: Application for 2019 Explosive Magazine Permits

As a reminder, the S.C. Explosives Control Act (§23-36-40) requires a permit be obtained from the State Fire Marshal for all Explosive Storage Magazines and the permit is valid for one calendar year (January 1- December 31).

For your convenience, a 2019 Magazine Permit Application is attached. You may make additional copies of the application as required. Completed applications must be mailed to the address shown above and must be postmarked prior to the expiration date. Incomplete or inaccurate applications will be returned to the applicant unprocessed and may result in your application not being postmarked by December 31, 2018. Applications not postmarked by the deadline may be subject to a late fee of \$100.00 per magazine.

Each application must include **all** of the following:

- Completed 2018 Magazine Permit Application for **each** magazine
- Copy of your company's applicable Federal Explosives License for **each** magazine
- Proper application fees (Payment must be made by check or money order payable to the "State of South Carolina"). **CREDIT CARDS ARE NO LONGER ACCEPTED FOR EXPLOSIVE MAGAZINE PERMITS.**

Remember, the S.C. Explosives Control Act requires that a new permit must be applied for (and in place) prior to January 1 of each year. If a magazine permit has not been applied for by the expiration date, explosive storage is not permitted in the magazine. By storing explosives in an unpermitted magazine, the individual will be in violation of the Explosives Control Act and may be subject to civil penalties up to \$1,000 per violation. In appropriate cases, the individual may also be subject to criminal sanctions, including fines or imprisonment.

South Carolina Law requires that every individual who applies for an occupational or professional license provide a social security number for use in the establishment, enforcement and collection of child support obligations and for reporting to certain databanks established by law. Other personal information collected by the Department for the licensing boards it administers is limited to such personal information as is necessary to fulfill a legitimate public purpose. The South Carolina Freedom of Information Act ensures that the public has a right to access appropriate records and information possessed by a government agency. Therefore, some personal information on the application may be subject to public scrutiny or release. The Department collects and disseminates personal information in compliance with The South Carolina Freedom of Information Act, the South Carolina Family Privacy Protection Act, and other applicable privacy laws and regulations. Additionally, the Department shares certain information on the application with other governmental agencies for various governmental purposes, including research and statistical services.
